MEDICAL ACCESS PROGRAM: WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ✓ Residents of Travis County

- ✓ Ineligible for Medicaid, CHIP, Medicare, or the Affordable Care Act Health Insurance Marketplace

- ✓ Meet Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines
 - Elderly & disabled **200% FPL**
 - Citizens & legal permanent residents **100% FPL**
 - Non-citizens/non-legal permanent residents **50% FPL**
 - Diagnosed with > 2 chronic conditions **100% FPL**

NOTE: Child support & assets are not counted as income

2018 FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES*

Family Size	50% FPL	100% FPL	200%
1	\$506	\$1,012	\$2,024
2	\$686	\$1,372	\$2,744
3	\$866	\$1,732	\$3,464
4	\$1,046	\$2,092	\$4,184

SLIDING FEE SCALE PROGRAM: WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ✓ Available to all residents regardless of county of residence and insurance status

- ✓ Live between 0 - 200% of the FPL*
 - * Patients over 200% of the FPL are considered self-pay patients
