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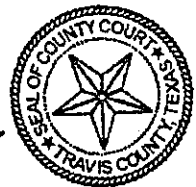

Central Health Board of Managers Shared Commitments **Agreed adopted on June 30, 2021**

Whereas, the Board of Managers of Central Health has come together as a governing body to ensure the Vision of Central Health: Central Texas is a model health Community;

Whereas, the Board of Managers of Central Health bring this vision into reality by enacting the mission of caring for those who need it most and thereby improving the health of our community;

Whereas, the Board of Managers of Central Health achieves excellence toward this vision and mission through the stated values of Stewardship, Innovation, Respect, and Collaboration;

Whereas, the Board of Managers of Central Health further known as we in this document understand that systemic racism is the root of health inequities that emerge from a history of racism in Texas including Travis County that contributes to the social determinants of health that play a primary role in producing inequitable health outcomes;

Whereas, as an organization, Central Health is anti-racist and committed to a diverse and inclusive culture that seeks equity and social justice in the pursuit of its mission:

1. We Commit to informing all of our actions as Board Managers with the understanding that we are accountable to recognizing and to interrupting systems of oppression. This includes understanding the power structure in the United States, and Texas, and Travis County, that advantages certain community members and has historically disadvantaged other community members based on the color of their skin, race, ethnicity, language, and/or other characteristics. We further understand that to disrupt this power structure and the health inequities it produces, we must collaborate to collectively respond to the lived realities of all ethnicities, races, and identities disadvantaged within this system and all historically oppressed identities and communities disadvantaged within this system. We Commit to understanding that when disadvantaged communities compete against each other, we all lose in this system, and the only way forward is to work together for the benefit of all oppressed communities collectively.
2. We Commit to a model of Generative Leadership which requires us to understand and practice collaboration and accountability demonstrated by following our agreed upon meeting procedures and ensuring all members have the opportunity for comparable speaking time. We further Commit to intentionality prior to speaking including: considering: what is the goal of what I

- want to share; is this the right time to share it; and is this in keeping with our collective goal for this particular moment within this particular meeting?
3. We Commit to Generative Conflict which includes engaging in disagreements and differences in perspective in a way that deepens relationships and trust by expanding knowledge and understanding of each other, including expecting our ideas to be expanded and enriched by learning and engaging with other Board Manager ideas, choosing curiosity over competition of ideas, and anchoring our conversations in our common purpose.
 4. We Commit to practicing emotional intelligence as leaders which includes being aware of our own emotions and reactions and managing them, as well as being aware of our impact on others and managing this impact for the collective good when we are in our role as Board Managers.
 5. We Commit to being aware of our own privileges and advantages in the sociopolitical and economic structure of the United States, Texas, and Travis County to use these for the benefit of interrupting inequities across historically disadvantaged identities.
 6. We Commit to preventing the commission of microaggressions through the awareness of the history and oppression of diverse identities and communities. To this end, we Commit to strive to learn the historical context informing the lived realities of all historically oppressed identities and communities, and to use this to prevent use of language and commission of actions that can be harmful given these histories.
 7. If we inadvertently commit a microaggression, we strive to immediately become aware on our own of the harm we have caused. If another Board Manager generously helps us become aware of a microaggression we have committed we welcome the support in our learning and growing process as a leader and immediately express appreciation for having made us aware, own the mistake we have made, acknowledge the impact of the harm we have caused, and engage repair through apology and the articulation of what we will do to avoid the repetition of such harm in the future.
 8. If we observe one of our fellow Board Managers commit a microaggression, we Commit to calling them in by letting them know in a respectful and kind manner of the mistake that has been made.
 9. We understand that many of us, as survivors of historically oppressed identities and communities, carry internalized narratives of oppression, and we can inadvertently express these oppressions against others in ways that cause harm and we Commit to the same process identified in 7 and 8 to engage repair and return to generative collaborative processes.
 10. We understand that even without the history of oppression potentiating the weight of harm, expressions of prejudice and rudeness can also cause harm to our shared aims, and we Commit to the same process identified in 7 and 8 to engage repair and return to generative collaborative processes.

11. We Commit to using our Racial and Social Justice Framework (next page) for decision-making as we work together for the collective good of our communities as we eradicate health inequities and create a model healthy community.
12. We understand that we are entrusted with a vital responsibility for our communities and are accountable stewards for the time and resources available to our Board of Managers. We understand that these commitments are entered into to ensure responsible stewardship of this time and resources through generative collaborative processes to reach our vision and mission and we agree that if we do not follow any one of these commitments we welcome our Board Manager colleagues to bring this to our attention through the agreed upon process reflected here and when this occurs, we commit to immediately acknowledging the mistake and engaging in a repair and correction process as indicated in these commitments so that our work to dismantle systemic racism and resulting barriers and achieve health equity can move forward.

Be it adopted that the above agreements will be honored and acted upon by each Board Manager as of 6/30/2021 and henceforth forward as indicated by signature below.

Calling In after Harm in Groups with Shared Values and Aims Stance

Hey, this thing you said/did hurt some folks or could hurt some folks.

A) Here's why that can be hurtful or,

B) Please do some research to learn the history of why that's hurtful.

Implied message: I know you are good and are on this journey with us and we are all going to make mistakes as we unlearn things.

Calling In after Harm in Groups with Shared Values and Aims Sample Language

- I know it wasn't your intention, but what you just said minimizes the horror of _____ e.g. the history of racism, enslavement, the holocaust, etc.
- I know it wasn't your intention but what you just said has the impact of implying that _____ are not competent or as intelligent as others.
- What you just said suggests that _____ people don't belong.
- That phrase has been identified as being disrespectful and painful to _____ people and it's important that we not use it.
- Oh, I have also used that term, but I have now learned that when we use it we are leaving out people who _____ or we are implying that _____ and the word people are learning to use now is _____.
- The term used now by people living with that identity is _____.

Repairing Harm after Microaggressions, Mistakes, and expressions of Prejudice

- Own / Name it
- Recognize the Impact
- Apologize (Do not share context or explanations)
- Make any amends that are possible
- State what you are going to do to learn and do better in the future.

Sample Language: Thank you so much for letting me know. RACIAL and SOCIAL JUSTICE FRAMEWORK

Values and Anti-Racism/Anti-Oppression

- Is this consistent with our values?
- Are we taking steps so we cannot predict outcomes by race and other systemically disadvantaged characteristics?

Intentional and Accountable Storytelling

- What data are we using and has it been disaggregated by race? What is the source of the data? Who is it making visible and invisible? Whose experience is being centralized and whose is being marginalized in the data? Does the way we are using the data reflect the complexity of the issues and reflect the issues accurately?
- What are the stories and narratives we are telling? What is the purpose? Who is interpreting the meaning? Who's it meant for? Who's impacted and how?
- Are we refusing to be ahistorical? Are we fully considering history and the impacts of the historical context?

Power Analysis

- What are the power dynamics in this situation? What are the intersecting spheres of oppression at work in this situation?
- What are the cultural norms of white supremacy at work in this situation?
- Who would benefit and who would be harmed by this action/decision?
- Does this interrupt/disrupt or collude with/reinforce oppressive systems/power structures?
- If this is attempting a solution, where are we locating the problem?
- Does the solution/strategy we are proposing change the system or the individual?
- Who are we asking to change and why?

Relationships

- Who is in the room and who isn't and why? Who is sharing and who is not and why?
- Whose perspective is represented/who is left out? And who is doing the representing? Who do we believe, who do we find credible? Why? Why not?
- Whose experience is being centralized and whose experience is being marginalized? Who is gazing and who is being gazed upon?
- Are we boldly leading toward our racial justice aim by building a broad coalition of support?
- Are we operating from a similar/shared understanding of anti-racism work? Do we have a shared anti-racist understanding of where the problem is located and a shared anti-racist theory of change to generate a solution? Have we agreed upon a shared goal?

2. Receive an update from the Central Health President & CEO on his first 100 days.

Clerk’s Notes: Discussion on this item began at 3:03 p.m. Dr. Patrick Lee, President & CEO presented his first 100 days report. He picked up where he left off at the May 22, 2024 Board of Managers meeting. Executives joined Dr. Lee as he walked through the purpose, value, and deliverables of his six Early Wins for Trust.

3. Present and discuss Central Health Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 proposed strategic priorities derived from the Healthcare Equity Plan, emerging priorities, including recommendations made by the board.

Clerk’s Notes: Discussion on this item began at 4:13 p.m. Dr. Patrick Lee, President & CEO; Ms. Monica Crowley, Chief Strategy & Planning Officer and Sr. Council; Mr. Jonathan Morgan, Chief Operating Officer; and Dr. Alan Schalscha, Chief Medical Officer, presented on the Central Health FY 2025 Proposed Strategic Priorities. The presentation first included a look at the FY25 strategic priorities and budget development timeline and where staff currently are in the process. Next, they shared that the FY25 proposed strategic priorities are guided by the Healthcare Equity Strategic Plan and reflect both ongoing and new operational and financial implementation planning work. They then shared that the emerging priorities, including those recommended by Board members, were derived from the Board validated driving forces. Next, they shared FY25 Proposed Strategic Priorities and FY25 Staff Emerging Priorities. Lastly, they shared FY25 Board member recommended emerging priorities and staff recommendations. They stated that the final FY25 strategic priorities, including staff and board recommended emerging priorities

will be used to develop the annual budget, and presented to the Board for formal adoption later in the summer.

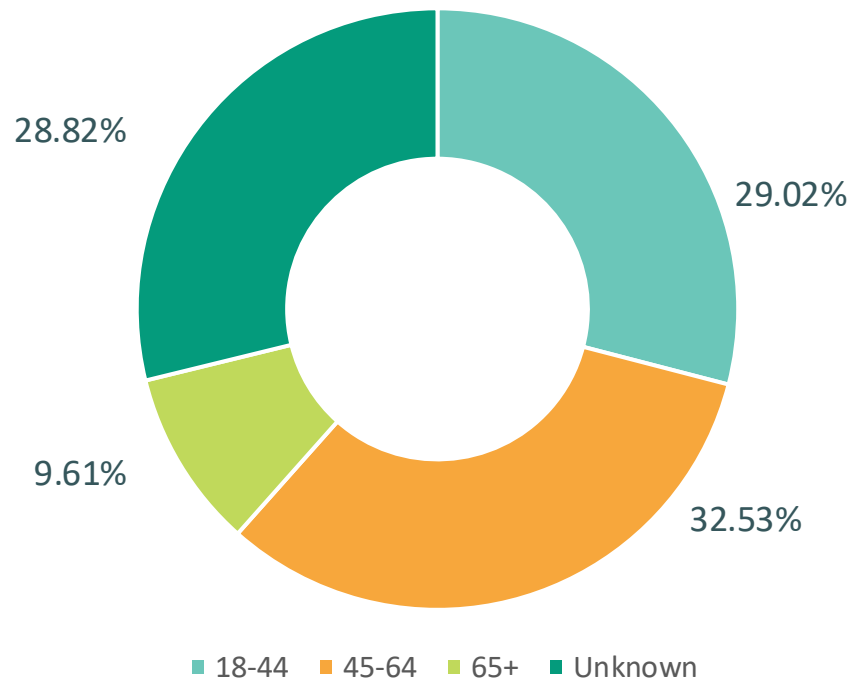

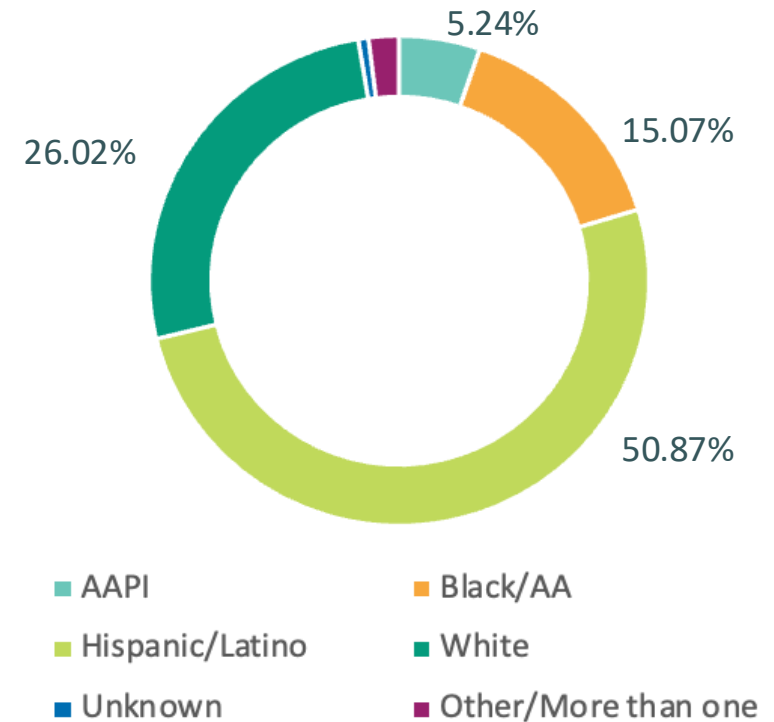
Demographics

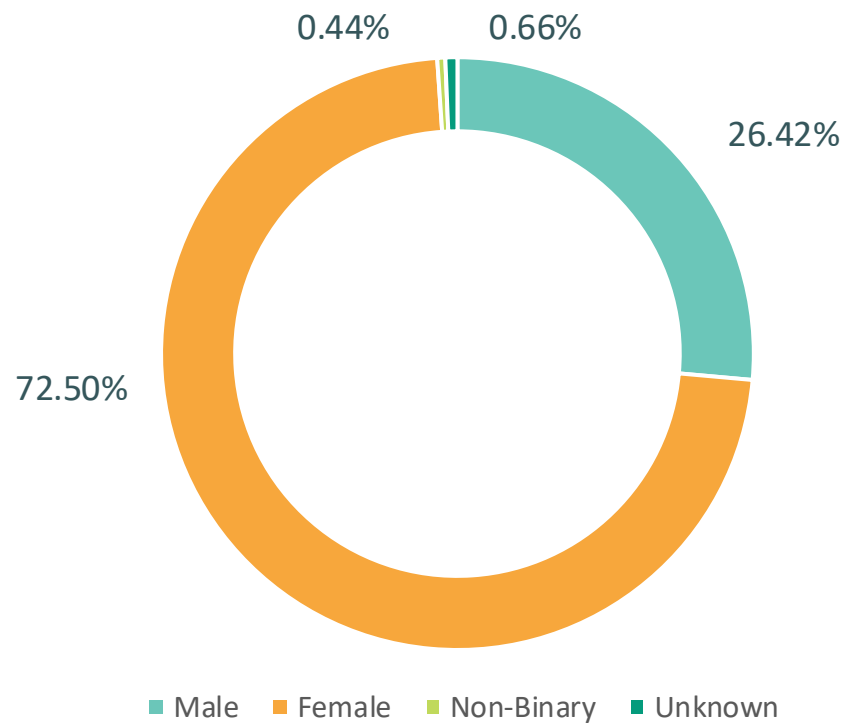
Race/Ethnicity

Re: Update on the Central Health Latino Family Support Conference

Overview:

In September 2023 championed by Mgr. Valadez, the Central Health Board of Managers adopted an amendment to the FY 2024 budget to include \$125,000 to plan a Latino Family Support Conference. Planning is underway for this conference, which will address the unique health challenges Latine’s face living at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level in Travis County. To guide the planning of the conference, staff created and convened three advisory committees. Tentatively scheduled for Sept. 2025, the conference will focus on the most common health conditions affecting Central Health’s Latine members.

Synopsis:

Staff adopted a collaborative approach to planning this conference, forming three advisory committees: one of staff and subject matter experts across the system, one of a wide array of external community partners who serve this population, and one of MAP members. This approach will help staff hold a community-led, culturally appropriate, and equity-based conference.

The conference aims to destigmatize chronic conditions and offer valuable information, resources, and support for prevention and management. Among Central Health’s MAP members, Latines are most impacted by these long-term health conditions:

- Heart disease
- High blood pressure
- Mental health
- Substance use disorders
- Diabetes

Staff have convened the first round of meetings with the advisory committees. The first decisions to make were establishing a time, date, and location for the conference. After meeting with the internal advisory committee, staff confirmed the outcome with the external partners advisory committee, and finally with the MAP patient advisory committee.

The patient advisory committee took the following points into consideration:

- The best day of the week for families to attend
- The best time of year to host the event
- The duration of the conference
- The public’s familiarity with the venue
- The venue’s visibility and ease of location

- Availability of ample parking
- Proximity to public transportation stops
- The venue’s suitability and capabilities for the event

The following recommendations came out of the first round of committee meetings:

- Day of the week: Saturday
- Conference duration: 4-5 hours between 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- Venue: Hyatt Regency Hotel & Conference Center
- Time of year: September 2025 – Hispanic Heritage Month

Fiscal Impact:

During FY 2024, staff estimate spending \$120,000 on the venue reservation; audio-visual technology for the event; breakfast, lunch, refreshments; and parking fees for approximately 400 attendees.

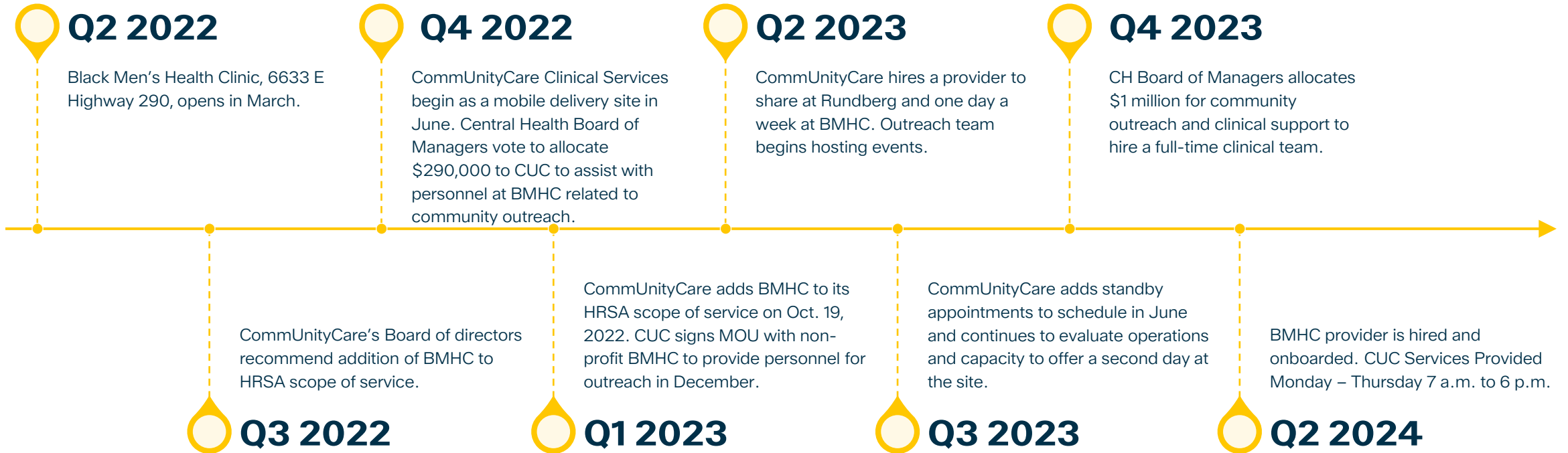

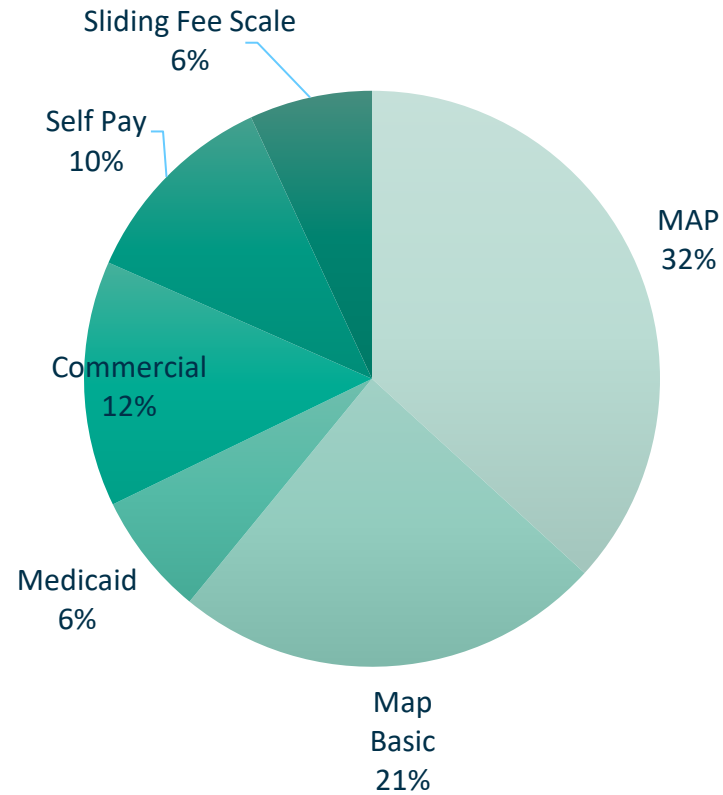

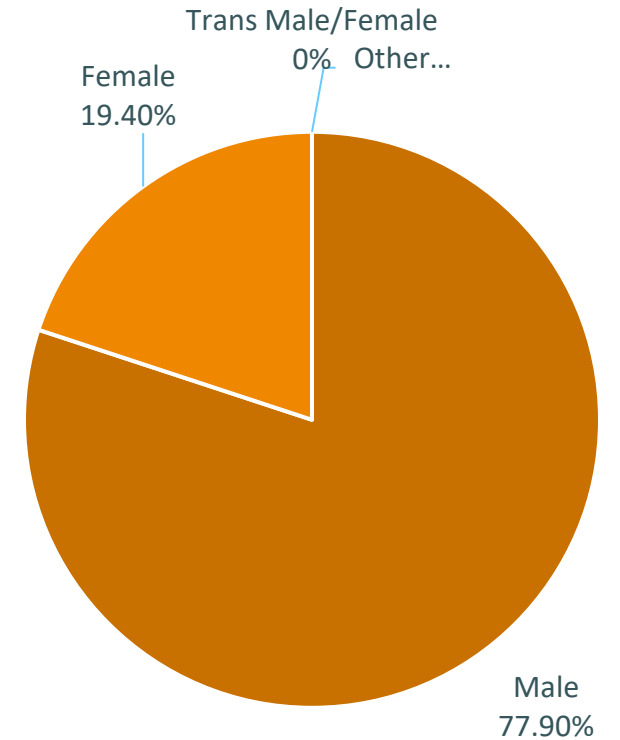

Gender Identity

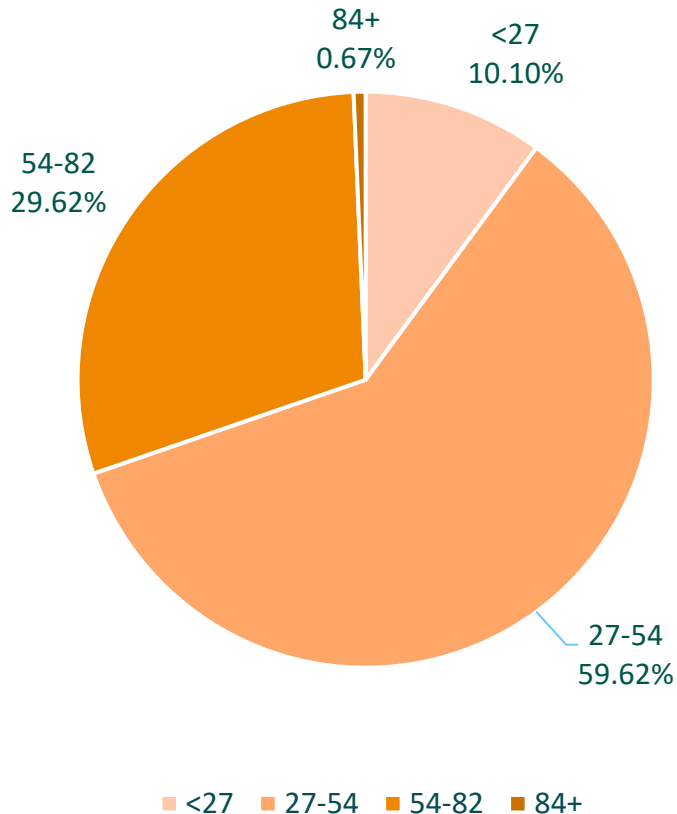
